School admissions for academic year 2025-2026 (for children going into Nursery, Reception and Year 6 only)

To the parents/carers of all **current Year 6 pupils**, you are required to submit an admission application for a Year 7 place at Cynffig or another comprehensive for September 2025 for your child/ren.

For children born between 1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014, who will be starting a Year 7 class in September 2025, the admission round is as follows:

Action	Date
Opening date for submission of applications	10am on Monday, 14 October 2024
Closing date for receipt of applications by the local authority	4pm on Friday, 17 January 2025

A Y7 place application **must be submitted** to secure your child's place. There is no automatic admission to a comprehensive school.



To the parents/carers of all **current full-time Nursery pupils**, you are required to submit an admission application for a Reception place at Corneli Primary school for September 2025 for your child/ren.

For children born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021, who will be starting a Reception class in September 2025, the admission round is as follows:

Action	Date
Opening date for submission of applications	10am on Monday, 11 November 2024
Closing date for receipt of applications by the local authority	4pm on Friday, 14 February 2025

A Reception place application **must be submitted** to secure your child's place. There is no automatic admission to our infant school, regardless of the school that a child currently attends as a Full-time Nursery pupil.



To the parents/carers of children **currently in part-time Nursery provision** and requiring a full-time Nursery place for September 2025, you are required to submit an admission application for a Nursery place at Corneli Primary school for September 2025 for your child/ren.

For children born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022, who will be starting full-time Nursery in September 2025, the admission round is as follows:

Action	Date
Applications open	10am on Monday 5 January 2025
Closing date for receipt of applications by the local authority	4pm on Friday 5 April 2024

A Nursery place application **must be submitted** to secure your child's place. There is no automatic admission to our primary school, regardless of the school that a child currently attends as a part-time Nursery pupil.

Home-to-school transport (from September 2025)

For many years the council has provided one of the most generous school and college transport offers in Wales. However, due to the unprecedented pressure on the council's budget, and in order to make significant financial savings, the council's Cabinet approved changes to the current Home-to-School/College Transport Policy in September 2024.

The new [policy](#) is available on the local authority website and will apply from September 2025.

The local authority will notify individual parents/carers in due course whether the policy change will affect their child(ren) from the start of the 2025-2026 school year.

From September 2025, if school transport eligibility is removed from your child, there is no appeal process and there will be no phased implementation or protection in place for any pupils.

Cabinet has agreed to the implementation of the following four policy changes:

Change 1 - Withdrawal of transport for all pupils benefitting from an identified and available (safe) walking route to school in line with statutory distances of two miles for primary school pupils and three miles for secondary school pupils.

Change 2 - Removal of the 'sibling' and 'in-receipt' protection for pupils.

Change 3 - Removal of all transport for Nursery pupils (excluding Welsh-medium and faith-based education).

Change 4 - Removal of all Post-16 transport (excluding Welsh-medium and faith-based education).

A summary of the eligibility of all pupils from September 2025 is as follows:

- For all primary school pupils (Reception to Year 6), transport will only be provided if they attend their catchment English-medium school or nearest Welsh-medium or faith school and live two miles or more from the school, or the walking route from the pupil's home is considered by the **local authority** to be unavailable.
- For all secondary school pupils (Year 7 to Year 11), transport will only be provided with free home-to-school transport if they attend their catchment English-medium school or nearest Welsh-medium or faith school and live three miles or more from the school, or the walking route from the pupil's home to the school is considered by the **local authority** to be unavailable.
- For Nursery pupils, transport will only be provided if they attend their nearest Welsh-medium or faith school and live 1.5 miles or more from the school, or the walking route from the pupil's home is considered by the **local authority** to be unavailable. There is no provision for pupils attending **any** English-medium schools.
- For Post-16 (sixth-form) pupils, transport will only be provided if they attend their nearest Welsh-medium or faith secondary school and live three miles or more from the school, or the walking route from the pupil's home to that school is considered by the **local authority** to be unavailable. There will be no provision for pupils attending **any** English-medium school or **any** further education college.

As I am sure you will understand, the decision to make these changes has not been taken lightly. It is important that parents/carers understand the impact of these changes. For more information, please see the council's [website](#).

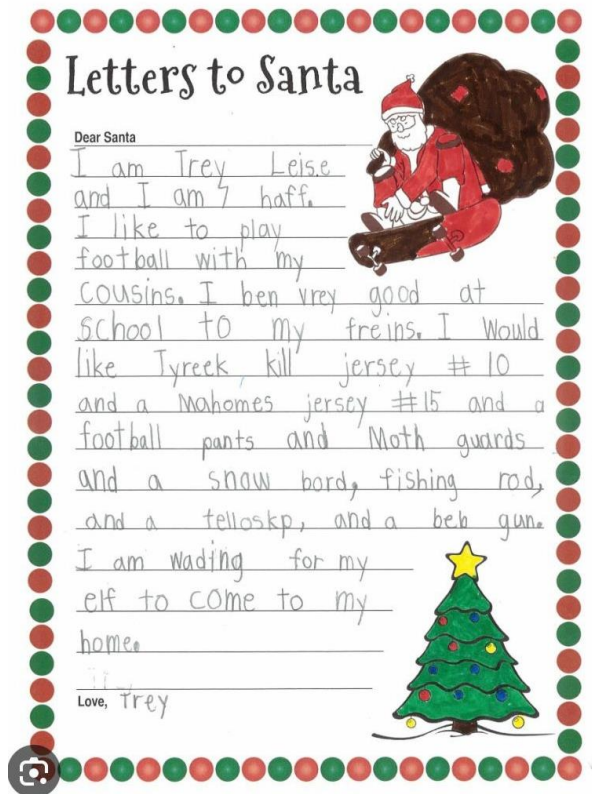
